PART 2 – ON-ROAD EQUIPMENT INSPECTION BY A POLICE OFFICER

This vehicle has all the necessary on-road equipment as required by the Michigan Vehicle Code.

UNIT A – FOUR-WHEEL MOTOR VEHICLES

LIGHTS

- Headlights (one each side, high and low beams)
 Turn signals (front and rear)
 Tail light (At least one. If equipped with two, both must work.)
 License plate light
 Brake lights

WINDSHIELD AND MIRRORS

- Safety Glass (no plexiglas, sufficient size to protect driver and passengers, no cracks, no obstructions, non-transparent material prohibited)
 Outside rearview mirror on driver's side (adjustable)
 Half-ton or more capacity trucks outside rearview mirrors on both sides

INTERIOR

- Horn
 Bright light indicator
 Windshield wipers
 Windshield washers
 Brakes (adequate to stop and hold the vehicle)
 Parking brake
 Safety belts (1965 and newer models)

EXTERIOR

- Bumpers (required on passenger vehicles, 14 to 22 inches above the ground except 4-wheel drive)
 Tires (2/32 inch tread, no exposed cord or tread separation, approved for highway use by D.O.T.)
 Exhaust (good working order, no excessive noise. Must include a tailpipe and resonator where the original design included a tailpipe and resonator)
 Differential gear

Over For Motorcycle and Trailer Equipment Inspection

UNIT B – MOTORCYCLE (Two or Three-Wheel Motor Vehicles)

- Headlight (high and low beams)
- Tail light
- Brake light
- License plate light
- Horn
- Brakes, front and rear (adequate to stop and hold the vehicle)
- Rearview mirror on left side (adjustable) Not required on vehicle if helmet has a mirror
- Tires (1/32 inch tread, no exposed cord or tread separation, approved for highway use by D.O.T.)
- Exhaust system (good working order, no excessive noise or annoying smoke)
- Seat (permanently attached)
- Handlebars (not higher than 15 inches from seat)
- Differential gear (three-wheel vehicles only)

UNIT C – TRAILERS 3,000 POUNDS GROSS WEIGHT OR LESS (Gross Weight = Trailer Plus Load)

NOTE: A Michigan title must be applied for if the trailer weighs 2,500 pounds or more empty.

- Tail light (at least one)
- Reflectors (two on the rear, at each side)
- Brake light (required ONLY when trailer or load obscures the stop light on the towing vehicle)
- License plate light
- Tires (2/32 inch tread, no exposed cord or tread separation, approved for highway use by D.O.T.)

UNIT D – TRAILERS MORE THAN 3,000 POUNDS GROSS WEIGHT (Gross Weight = Trailer Plus Load)

- Tail light (at least one)
- Brake light (at least one)
- License plate light
- Clearance lamps; two on the FRONT (one at each side); two on the REAR (one at each side)
- Side marker lamps (two on each side, one at or near the front and one at or near the rear)
- Reflectors: two on each side (one at or near the front and one at or near the rear); two on the rear (one at each side)
- Tires (2/32 inch tread, no exposed cord or tread separation, approved for highway use by D.O.T.)
- If 5,500 pounds gross weight or more, brakes on all wheels

UNIT E – POLE-TRAILER

- Tail light (at least one)
- License plate light
- Side marker lights (one on each side)
- Clearance lights (one on each side)
(Side marker and clearance lights may be in combination, to show to the front, side or rear.)
- Reflectors (one at each side on the rear of the pole-trailer or load)
- Tires (2/32 inch tread, no exposed cord or tread separation, approved for highway use by D.O.T.)
